PROGRAM COSTS FOR UNSPONSORED PROGRAMS AND PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Space/Aerospace Science and Engineering Programs

The new M.Sc. programs in Space/Aerospace Sciences and Engineering follow a structure very similar to AUST's existing programs, namely, **18 months duration**, consisting of a 12-month component during which mandatory coursework will be taken, followed by a 6-month research component. The fees will therefore be as follows:

The following programs are structured as “taught” programs, as they are based on intensive instruction over a **12-month period**, with a limited amount of independent research:

- M.Sc. Applied Statistics
- M.Sc. Mathematical Modelling
- M.Sc. Management of Information Technology
- Master’s in Public Policy
- Master’s in Public Administration
