4.0 STUDENT HONOR CODE AND STUDENT CONDUCT CODE: STUDENT CONDUCT COMMITTEE

The Student Conduct Committee, composed of students, faculty and staff, is appointed by the President for the purpose of hearing cases concerning alleged violations of the Student Honor Code and Student Conduct Code. Members serve for a period of one year and may be reappointed. Recommendations for the appointment of members are made by the Registrar and the Vice President, to the President.

A hearing panel is comprised of eight (8) members. Five (5) members constitute a quorum. One member of the hearing panel must be a faculty or staff member, and a majority of the panel must be student members. Staff of the Office of the President will not serve on a hearing panel. The President or designee shall appoint an administrative liaison to the panel and shall not be a member of the panel. The administrative liaison will convene members of the committee to serve as a hearing panel, provide relevant information to the panel, and advise the panel throughout the hearing process.

The Student Conduct Committee shall hear the case and submit a written report to the Vice President or designees. The written report will contain findings of facts and recommended sanctions, if any. If the student is found responsible for the violation or violations, the committee shall recommend one or more sanctions as provided in the African University of Science and Technology, Abuja Regulation 10.0. The Vice President or designees may adopt, reject or modify the Committee's findings and recommendations.
